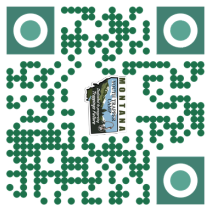

WHO IS YTC - WHAT DOES IT DO?

The three day camp is held annually in Montana and has been incorporated as a nonprofit educational organization which allows all contributions to be fully tax deductible.

The camp is held in June. Accommodations are semi-private with attendees providing their own tents, campers, RVs and personal items. All meals, snacks, drinks and eating utensils are provided.

The camp is geared towards family participation. Campers will attend classes on trapping methods, ethics, regulations, fur handling, health and safety. Camp instructors come from the MTA trapper education program.

Funding for YTC comes from camp fees, YTC Membership Gifts, Individual and Corporate donations. YTC, Inc. provides scholarships for youth attendees if requested, prior to April 15 each year.

WHO MAY ATTEND YTC?

- Any youth under the age of 18
- Youth 10 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult
- Youth do not have to be a member of the MTA
- Youth with special needs must have an adult chaperon
- Any person over 18 may attend as a camper, chaperon or volunteer
- Family participation is encouraged
- Attendees are selected on a first come, first accepted basis
- First year participants will attend 9 classes dealing with trapping basics, conservation, regulations, ethics, furbearer ID, safety and health
- Returning participants will receive more intense hands on training
